Miss School, Miss Out!

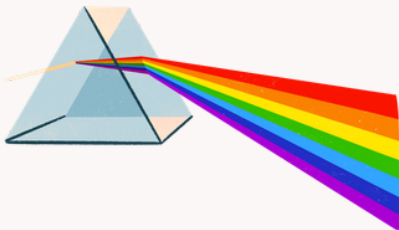
We have lots of exciting things coming up next week and if you miss school, you will miss out!

PE KITS AND UNIFORM



PE Kit, Uniform & Jewellery Reminder

A quick reminder to ensure that your child has the correct PE kit in school each Monday. PE kits should include:

- **Plain white T-shirt**
- **Blue or black shorts**
- **Blue or black jogging bottoms**
- **Blue or black long-sleeved top**

Please remember that **branded clothing is not permitted** as part of the PE kit.

We would also ask that all **items of school uniform and PE kit are clearly named**. This makes it much easier for us to return lost items to their rightful owner and helps to prevent belongings from going missing.



Earrings & PE

For safety, children who wear earrings should only wear **plain stud earrings**. Earrings must be **removed for PE lessons to prevent injury**.

Thank you for your support in helping us to maintain our school expectations and keep our children safe.

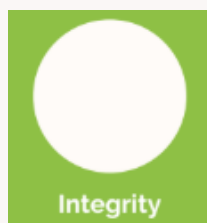


How did we SHINE this week?

Class 4	Isaac-Jones, for quickly settling into Kellington. You have been a shining example of The Kellington Way.

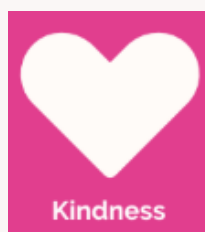
