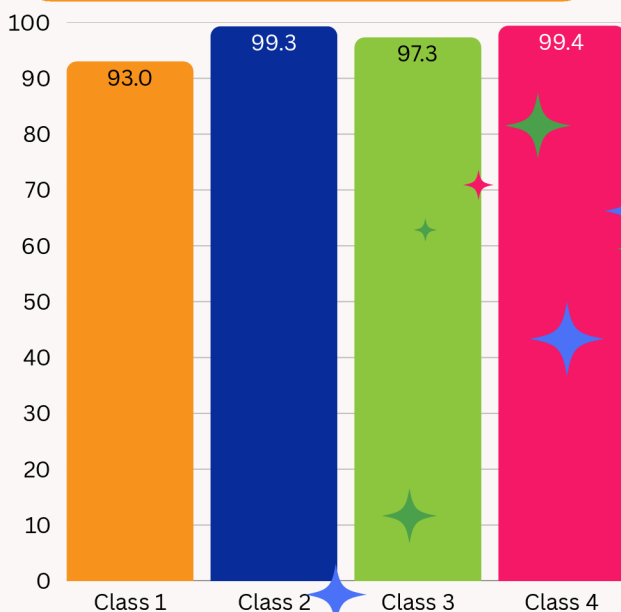
Maths in Action

We have been made aware of some cases of headlice. Please check your child's hair to ensure we get rid of these unwelcome visitors!

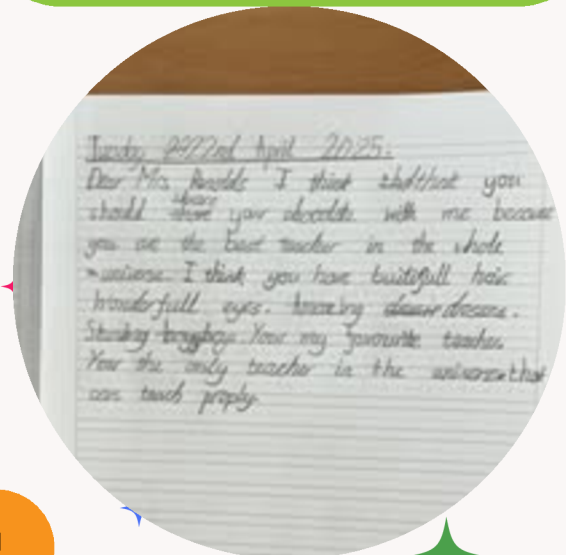
