EYFS stay and play will be on Friday 8th March from 08:45am - 09:45am and will be for Mothers Day.

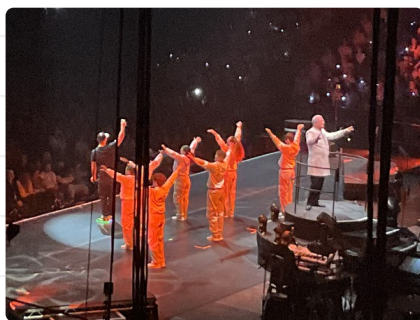
Young Voices
