- Do not miss out on important learning which is the building blocks to high school preparation and their futures! This cannot be regained.

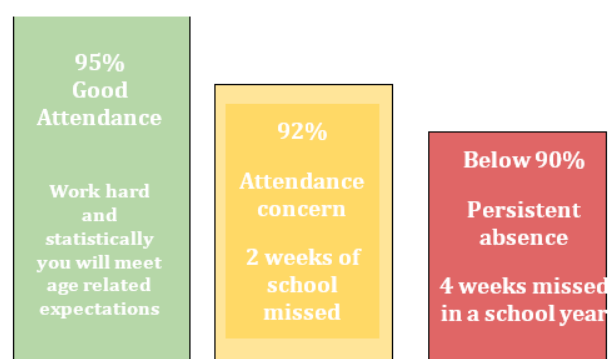

If you have only 10 days off school (either authorised or unauthorised), your attendance will only be:

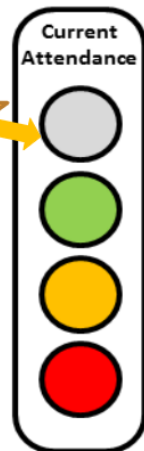
94.7%

For **every minute** that a student is late to school or a lesson, or misses a day, they are **losing learning time**. This will significantly affect their **progress**.
