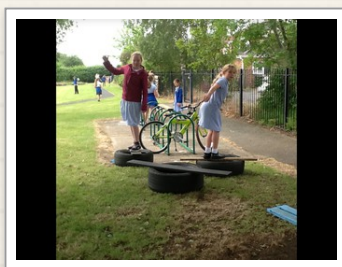
They had the best day ever!

30 Hours Nursery Announcement

All Nursery aged children are entitled to 15 hours of free early education. Kellington Primary School currently provides this provision from 8.45am to 11.45 each day.

We are pleased to announce that from September 2023, we will be able to offer 30 hours of free childcare from September for eligible families!

From September 2017 the vast majority of working parents of children aged 3 and 4 years old are entitled to up to 30 hours free childcare a week. A child qualifies for this free childcare if they are resident in England and under compulsory school age. If both parents are working (or the sole parent in a lone family) and are earning a weekly minimum wage **equivalent** to 16 hours at national minimum wage/national living wage, approximately £120 a week.

If you are eligible you will be sent a code for 30 hours free childcare via the government portal. You must bring this code to the school office along with your National Insurance number, and your date of birth. Once we have verified your code, you will be offered a place.

Sessions for 30 hour provision will run:

Monday to Thursday 8.45 to 3.15pm. On Fridays, our 30 hours offer will finish at 11.45am, however an additional session can be purchased for Friday afternoons at a cost of £16.80. For those families who wish to access more than 15 hours but are not eligible for 30 hour funding, we do offer the ability to purchase additional afternoon sessions at £16.80 per session plus £3.10 for the lunchtime session.

Children who attend for full days can purchase a school lunch, these cost £1.80 currently however there may be a small price increase in September, or bring a packed lunch. Please contact the admin team on admin@kp.starmat.uk with your requirements for the autumn term. Bookings to be made by 30th June to allow us to plan for the autumn term.

Get active with the Summer Reading Challenge 2023!

Children can once again sign up for the Summer Reading Challenge at their local library during the holidays. This year the theme is Ready Set Read! and is all about the power of play, sport, games and physical activity.
