

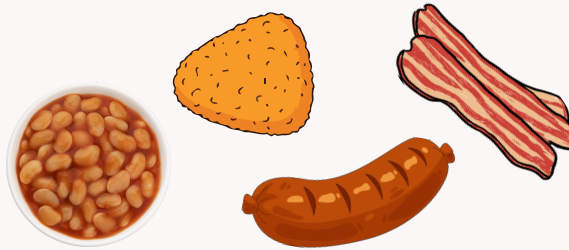

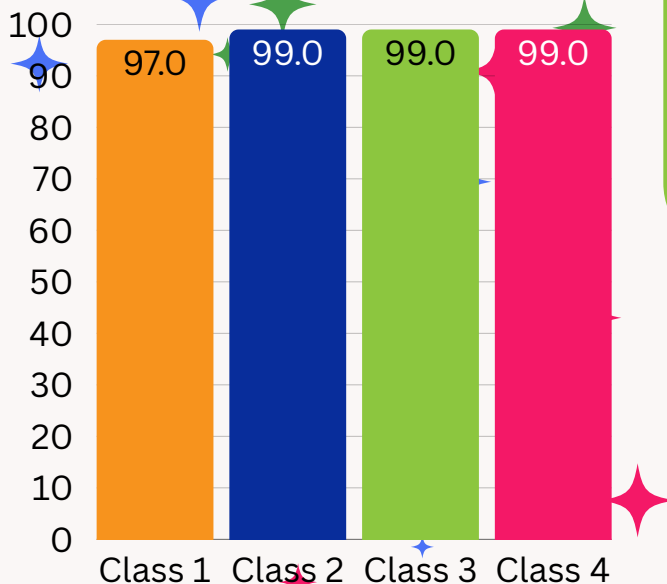
Class 2 will be using mixed media in art to explore patterns and lines!
