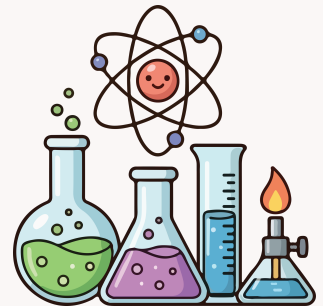

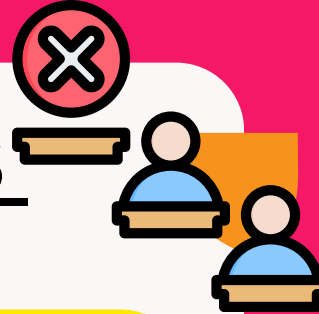

# Attendance and Lateness



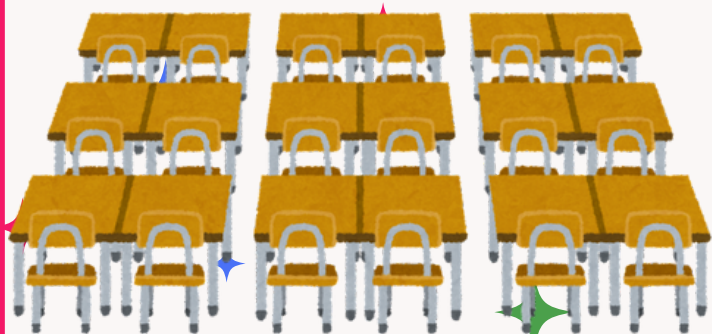
## On Time vs Lost Learning!

Being on time is crucial to starting the school day positively, knowing what is happening in the day and making the most of learning.

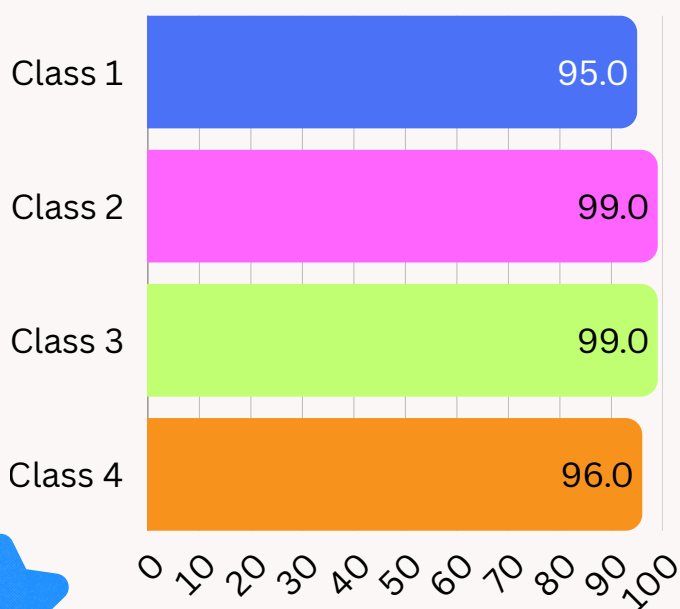

It has been amazing to see how each of the children's skills have developed across their sessions throughout the year - well done!

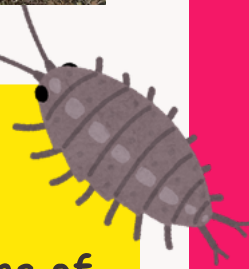


## Headlice
