speaker

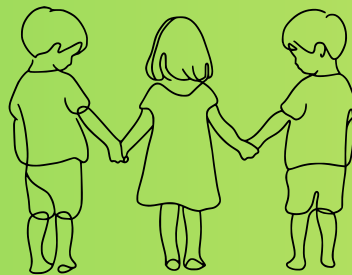
have

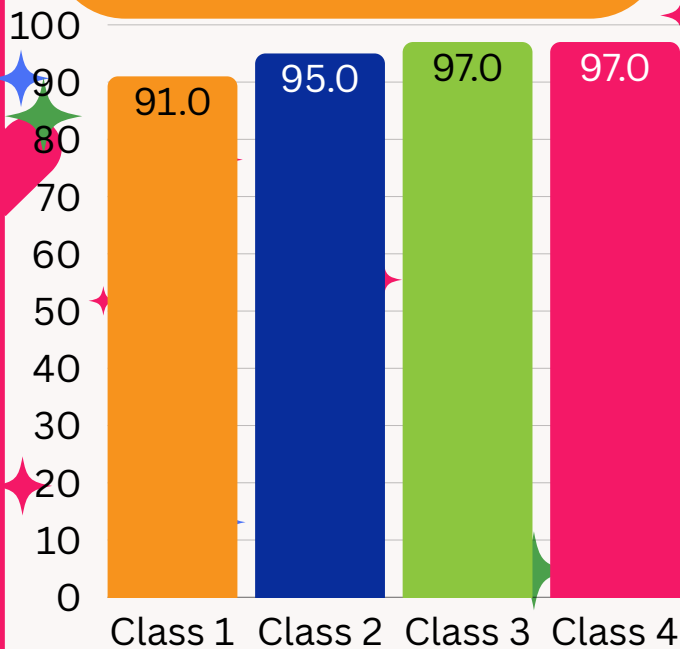

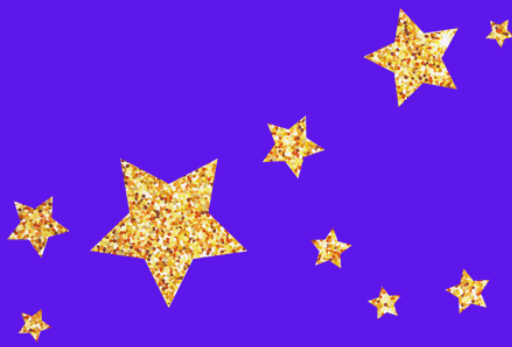
