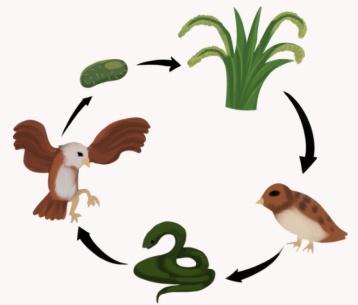

# Attendance and Lateness



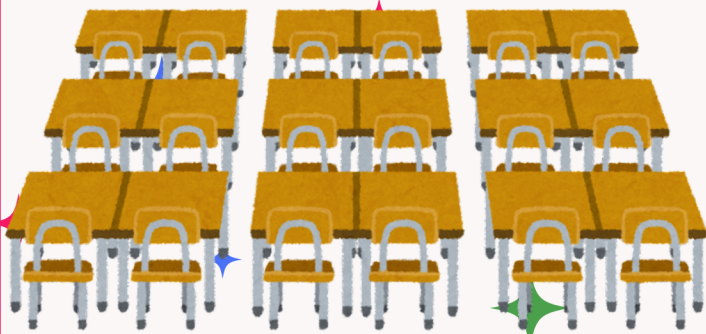
## On Time vs Lost Learning!

Being on time is crucial to starting the school day positively, knowing what is happening in the day and making the most of learning.

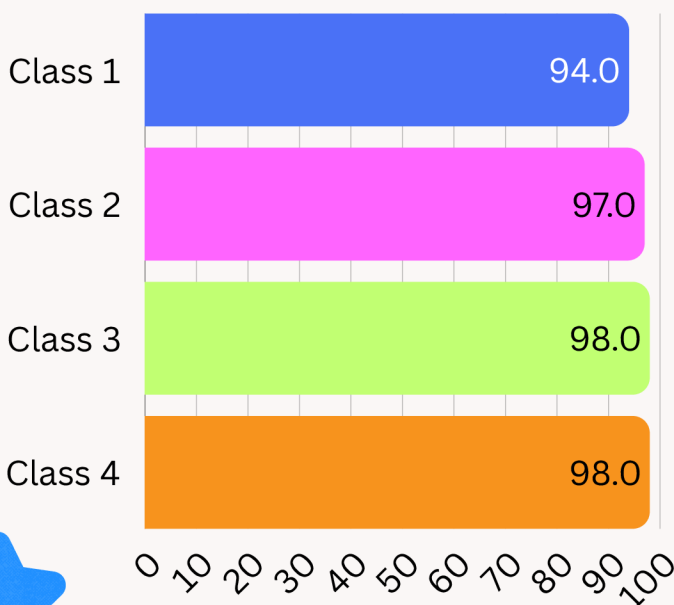
