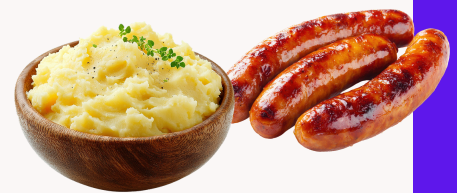

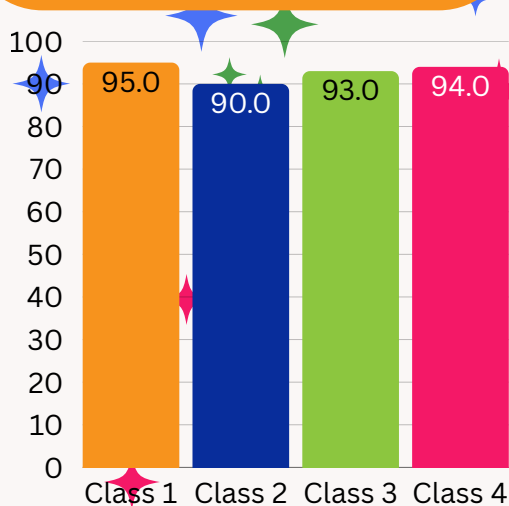

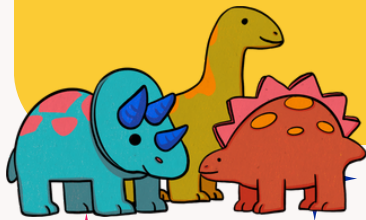


Break the Rules Day is Back!

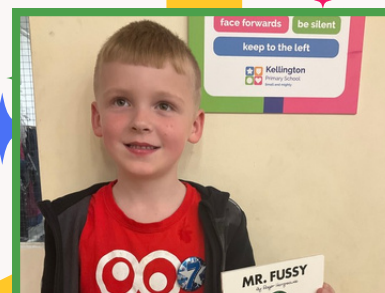
