Resilience Award

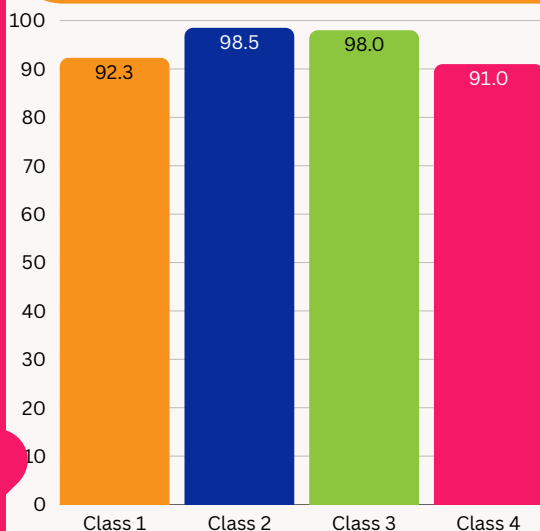
Bohdi (YR) for showing resilience in all that you do! you tackle every task with determination, enthusiasm and a big smile!
