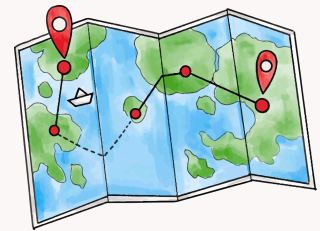

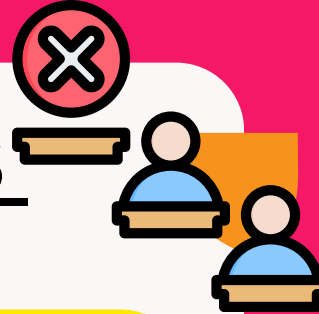

Attendance and Lateness



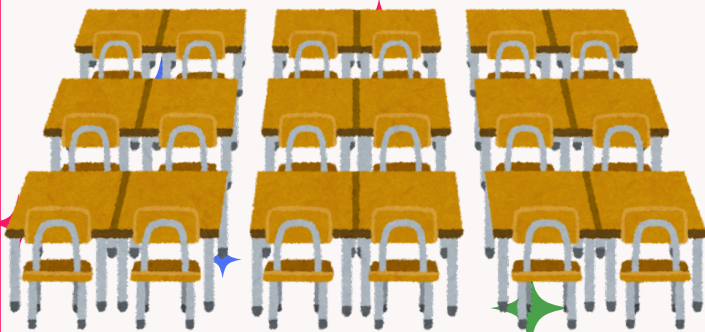
On Time vs Lost Learning!

Being on time is crucial to starting the school day positively, knowing what is happening in the day and making the most of learning.

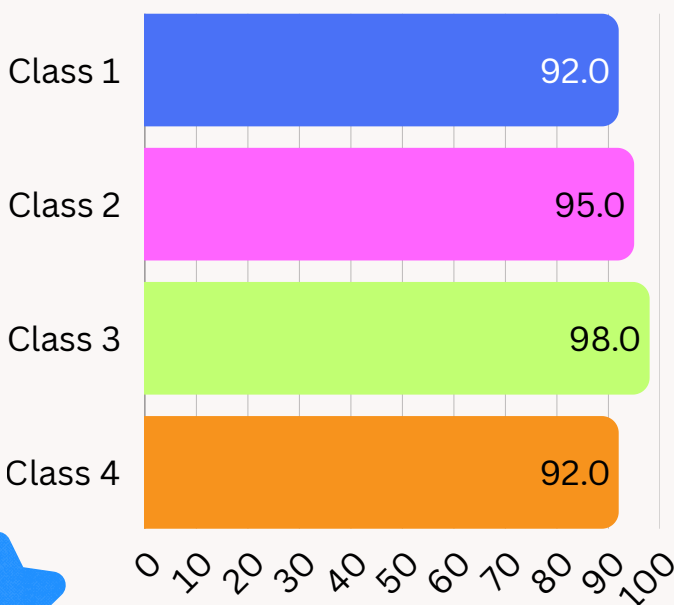

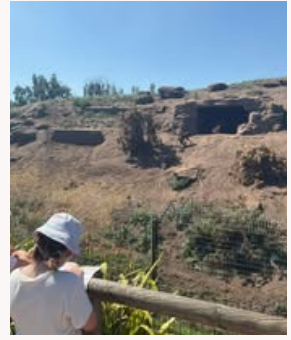
