Resilience Award

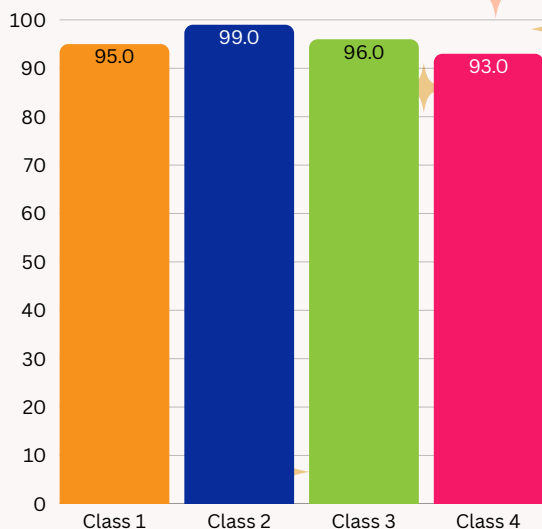
Kayson T for showing great resilience while attending school with a broken arm.
