

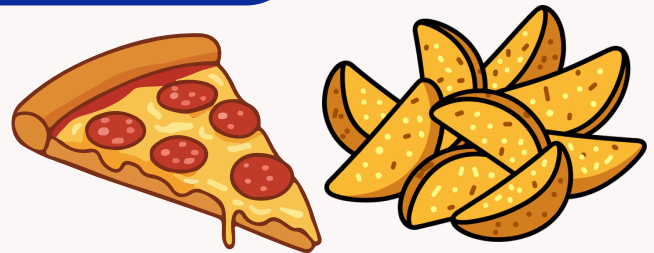

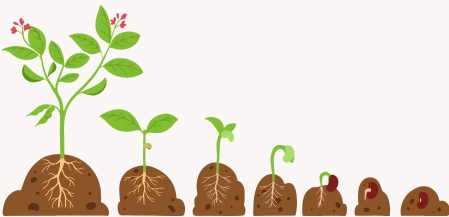

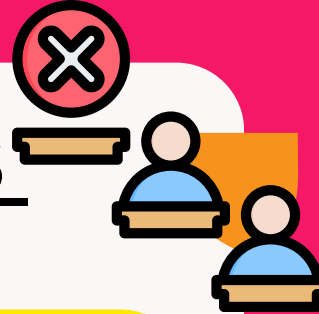

On Time vs Lost Learning!

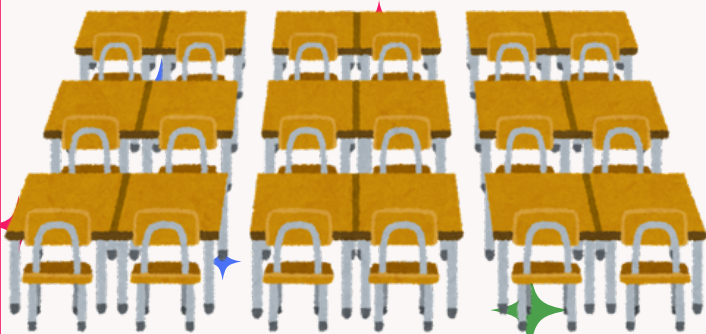
Being on time is crucial to starting the school day positively, knowing what is happening in the day and making the most of learning.

In just 4 days, we have collectively been late by 223 minutes. This is the same as over half of a day's learning.

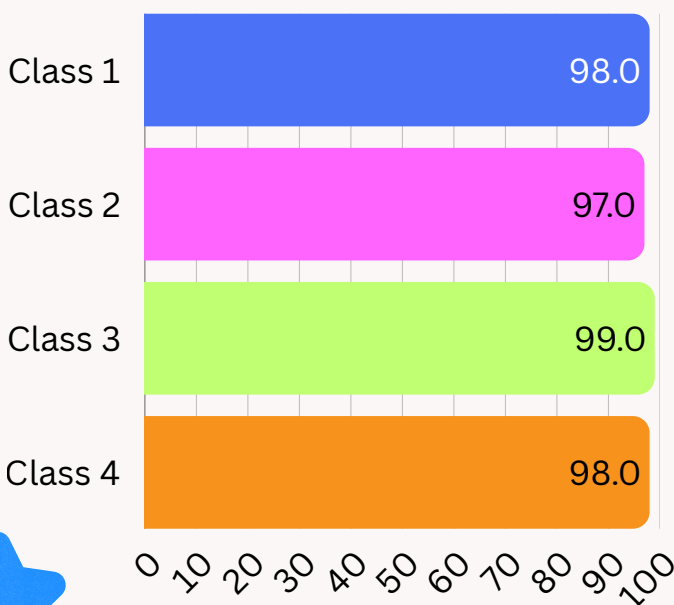
This could mean missing English, Maths, Science and specific targeted work to help your child progress.

Please can they come with sports clothes/PE kit to change into.



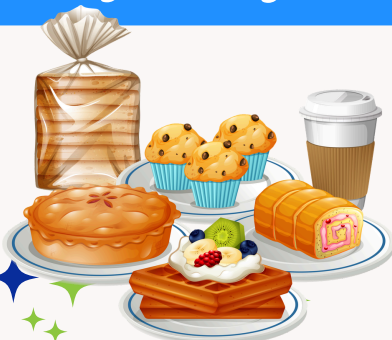
