A word from Mrs Lawrence...

Welcome back to another exciting half term at KPS. I do hope you all had a lovely half term and are ready for the run up to Christmas.

I thought I would start with a quick update on the works we have done in school over the half term holidays. We have had new carpeting in our key stage two classrooms and new blinds installed across the school. We are also excited to share that our Cabin is ready to use and we will be taking small groups of children into it for interventions. Please do have a peep through the windows if you are able.

On Monday, we launched our new Attendance Stars Reward system. Each week classes will have the opportunity to work towards achieving rewards for coming to school regularly and for being on time. Classes will be given Attendance 10 stars for achieving over 95% attendance and Attendance 15 stars for achieving 100% attendance. These stars can be then exchanged for free time and can be used as an individual amount or collectively over the half term. The children were very excited and can't wait to achieve the first stars which will be awarded on Monday.

We have also introduced new presentation guidance, which has been shared with all children and is displayed in classrooms. Our focus this half term will be to encourage all children to focus on how their work is presented to ensure that it is of a high quality.
